Instructions

- 1. Each hymn is listed by hymn tune name as well as the most common or standard text.
- 2. A blank is available to fill in the page number of the hymn from your hymnal.
- 3. Space has also been provided for you to write in alternate texts that are most often used with these hymn tunes.
- 4. If the "tag" begins before the final measure of the hymn has concluded, then the final bar is provided.
- 5. If the "tag" begins independently, then the hymn's conclusion is omitted.
- 6. Choir singers will need to have their hymnals in one hand and the "tag" in the other, ready to execute in a timely manner.
- 7. It is often wise to begin the "tag" without allowing for any slowing in the hymn's cadence.
- 8. It is recommended that the "tag" be sung at a slightly faster pace than the hymn, then slowing as the music dictates.
- 9. There may be other ways to use these "tags" such as introits and benedictions.
- 10. In whatever manner these "tags" are used, may they further glorify God.
