Jasper Randall's *The Cloths of Heaven* was the winner of the 2017 CCDA George Heussenstamm Choral Composition Contest at the ECCO Summer Conference.

Growing up in a small town in the Oregon coastal range, composer Jasper Randall began studying piano at the age of 5 and composing at 13. Upon graduating from Azusa Pacific University with a degree in composition, Randall was accepted into the prestigious Scoring for Motion Pictures and Television program at the University of Southern California.



In 2014, Jasper was appointed Composer In Residence of the Los Robles Master Chorale by Artistic Director Lesley Leighton, officially starting his entry into choral writing. One of his first choral compositions, *Alleluia*, won the 37th Annual Choral Composition Competition held at Ithaca College. *The Cloths of Heaven* was commissioned by Lesley Leighton on behalf of the Los Angeles Master Chorale Chamber Singers for the 27th Annual High School Choral Festival, held at the Walt Disney Concert Hall in Los Angeles, California.

In addition to his film, television, commercial and choral works, Jasper has established himself as one of the foremost vocal contractors in the entertainment industry. He has contracted, conducted and performed in over 250 films and television shows.
